Zimbabwean marimba is an ensemble style of playing that was developed to teach African music to Zimbabwean children in the 1960's. In 1968, this music was brought to the United States, where its popularity has steadily grown. Zimbabwean marimba is upbeat and joyful, and accessible to children and adults alike regardless of previous experience. It is traditionally taught by rote, rather than from notation. Instruments are provided at the studio. Arrangement of 7-piece marimba accompaniment for African or Caribbean choral songs. I arrange and teach marimba or Orff accompaniment to African choral tunes for collaboration with local choirs.
